Dear Fellow AFGE Local 1770 Members,

Nominations for the Offices of **President, Executive Vice President, Secretary Treasurer, Chief Stewart, Main Unit VP, Pope VP, DECA VP, Schools VP** and five members of the Executive Council at Large will be accepted from the floor during the nomination meeting on 7 May2019 at 1630. The meeting will take place at the Union Hall located at 2655 Reilly Road, Fort Bragg, NC (Bldg. 4-1571.)

Qualifications to run for office:

- Must be a member in good standing of this local (any member who has paid dues through 7 May2019.) Must be a member for one (1) year of an AFGE local (any member who has paid dues through 7 May2019.)
- Must not be a member in any labor organization not affiliated with the AFL-CIO
- No member shall be a candidate for more than one office

Any member in good standing is eligible to nominate candidates to run for office. A second to a nomination is not required. Self-nominations are permissible. Nominations may also be made in writing and must be received by the election committee no later than 1630 hours on 7 May2019. Mail-in nominations should be addressed to:



Candidates must accept nominations in person or in writing. Written acceptance must be received by the election committee NLT close of the nomination meeting on 7 May2019. Members making nominations have the responsibility of informing nominees of their nomination intent. Candidate name placement on ballots will be determined by the election committee at the close of the nomination meeting. The term of office will run for 3 years, ending with the installation of officers following the regularly scheduled elections in 2022.

Election Day will be 21 May2019. There will be a ballot box available at the Union Hall from 0600 to 1800 hours for those who wish to vote in person. Any members not present during the nomination meeting or election may make nominations, or request an absentee ballot (respectively), in writing. Election documents will be available at the Union office. Written requests must include rationale for the absentee option. Each candidate may have one observer, who is a member in good standing, present throughout the election process. All ballots will be counted and the results announced by the Election Committee on 21 May2019. Ballots received after 1800 on Election Day will not be counted.

The elected officers will be installed at the next monthly union meeting. **REMEMBER THIS IS YOUR UNION LOCAL AND IT IS YOUR VOTE.**
